Minutes

Agenda Item: Introductions of attendee

Meeting Summary: The council meeting focused on updates and planning for upcoming events and initiatives. Kristina provided updates on the communication campaign, including National Drug and Alcohol Facts week and changes to Narcan availability, noting that the generic version will now come with one dose per box instead of two. The team discussed upcoming events including a laundry day at the Greenup Laundromat, a candlelight vigil planned for August 28th, and a bowling event scheduled for June 4th at Thunder Lanes. The group identified the need for two additional DOPP sites and discussed potential locations including the Hubcap and local businesses. Angie Hunt offered to connect with Neoga's mayor, Tom, to help facilitate recovery month proclamation. The conversation ended with discussions about improving meeting attendance and engagement, including the possibility of personal invitations to key stakeholders.

Narcan Update: Kyle provided updates on the transition from Narcan to generic naloxone, explaining that while the formulation remains effective the name and box color will change.

Past Events: The team reviewed recent events including a successful recovery housing panel and a St. Patrick's Day event at the library.

Upcoming Events: Kristina discussed upcoming events and activities. She confirmed a bowling event scheduled for June 4th from 6-8pm at Thunder Lanes in Neoga, and mentioned plans for a Recovery Month event at Calgary Tabernacle Church's New Family Life center. A Candlelight Vigil has been scheduled for August 28th and plans are being made to celebrate Recovery Month in September.

Drug Take Back: Madison announced a National Drug Take Back Day event scheduled for April 25th in Cumberland County.

Communication Campaign: April is Alcohol Awareness Month, a time dedicated to increasing understanding about alcohol misuse and encouraging open conversations about prevention, treatment, and recovery. Asking the question “*Do I have a drinking problem?*” can be the first step toward understanding and seeking the council invites community members, local organizations, and service providers to participate in Alcohol Awareness Month by sharing educational information, encouraging conversations about alcohol use, and supporting individuals and families affected by substance use.

DOPP Sites: The group discussed challenges in finding two additional DOPP (Drug Overdose Prevention) sites needed by year-end, with Kristina reporting limited success at local businesses and liquor stores.

. Reminders/Tasks:

- Madison: Email Drug Take Back Day flyers to the group once Jennifer completes them.
- Kristina: Notify everyone when the new naloxone (generic Narcan) boxes are available and provide information about the change.
- Kristina: Place informational signs at distribution sites about the change to single-dose boxes.
- Kristina: Continue outreach to add two more DOPP (Distribution of Product) sites by the end of the year; follow up with potential locations (e.g., Loves, Neoga Bar & Grill, Hubcap, etc.).
- Kristina: Follow up with the Neoga Bar & Grill (contact Cameron Wingler) about becoming a DOP site.
- Angie: Email Mayor Tom (Tommy) of Neoga to set up an introductory meeting about ROSC and recovery month proclamation, including Kristina (and possibly Sara) on the email.
- Kristina: Send Angie a reminder email about contacting Mayor Tom.
- Sara: Ask Erica (nurse/EMT) to write a community article/blurb about naloxone availability and trainings for Facebook and local paper.
- All: Think of and suggest additional DOPP site locations to Kristina.
- Kristina: Send personal invitations/contacts (not just group emails) to key providers (e.g., Debbie Cunningham) to encourage attendance at upcoming meetings.
- Kristina: Consider inviting local law enforcement (e.g., detectives from drug task force) to present at or attend future meetings.
- Kristina: Distribute Skylar's MAR (Medication Assisted Recovery) brochure in Cumberland County, adding local provider information as needed.
