**Standing Coalition Business:**

- Minutes from the March meeting were not approved as revisions need to be made.

**New and Standing Coalition Reports:**

- James Mullins (Turning Point Treatment) spoke on behalf of the faith-based, sober-living facility based in Princeton, IN. This facility currently houses 6 men, with hopes to provide housing for up to 12 within the year. They utilize the “Navigate” program as well as the “Genesis” program used in courts. The focus is to identify behavior and make long-term changes during recovery. He added that they spend time outdoors, as well as quality time with dogs. They find that time spent working outdoors helps build a “family” feeling among those at the facility. They also work closely with the court system and the probation officers. Employment is an important goal at the facility, as well as helping them find a “vision” for their life during recovery. The weekly cost is approximately \$200.00, but added that cost isn't what they focus on and they work with those at the facility to make it financially possible. The intake process can be done over the phone, to make things easier for those looking for a good fit for them. James will share the brochure with Chris, so it can be distributed to the council members.

- Kindra York (EHD) spoke on the Saline County Outreach event to be held on May 9th from noon-4 p.m. This event will take place at Harrisburg Park and will offer food, the Amazon truck, haircuts, and clothing. This is the biggest recovery event in Southern Illinois, and continues to grow. Attendees will be addressed by four speakers and have access to many local vendors.
- Chris Dennis and Holly Kotner (EHD) updated the council on MAR awareness education. Plans are being made to display informational ads on the tables at Tequilas Restaurant in Harrisburg. It was also discussed that information needs to be made available in Hamilton and White Counties as well.
- Kindra York (EHD) announced a “first time” event being held on Wednesday, April 29th at 10:00. Tri-State Food Bank is hosting a mobile food drive in McLeansboro at the City Hall. Kindra will share a flyer with the council and is asking that the event be shared on social media.
- Chris Dennis added the Southern Illinois Recovery Network Regional Conference is taking place at SIC on May 22nd from 9:00-4:30. This event is for recovery peer supporters as well as community health workers. There will be several guest speakers, as well as breakout sessions and an award ceremony. Lunch will also be provided at the conference.
- Drew Donnelson (EHD) gave the following report from March 2026
  - 1,885 Naloxone kits distributed
  - 785 individuals trained
  - 500 test strips distributed
  - 100 Xylazine strips distributed
- Nicole Schoenborn (Hamilton County Opioid Coordinator) added that the next Opioid Coalition meeting will be held Tuesday, April 21st at 9:00.
- Motion was made by Holly Kotner to adjourn this meeting, with Nicole Schoenborn seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
