**Standing Coalition Business:**

- Minutes from the March meeting were approved unanimously with a motion made by Danielle Camp. Jennifer Owen seconded the motion.

**New and Standing Coalition Reports:**

- Jennifer Owen (By His Grace) reported a new location for their non-profit organization. They are now located at 508 W. Poplar Street in Harrisburg. (The former Stress and Trauma building). This center will soon be opening and be available for “drop ins” as peer recovery support will be available. They are hosting an outreach event scheduled for May 9th and a flyer will soon be shared with the council. They plan to create brochures to distribute in the community. She added that there is a Recovery Cafe Network meeting planned for next week.
- Danielle Camp (EHD) announced that the next SI SUPRT meeting will be in-person and will take place on Wednesday, May 6th at noon at the iHub in Eldorado. In addition, she gave the following statistics from March 2026:
  - 1709 kits of Naloxone were distributed
  - 731 individuals were trained in the use of Naloxone
  - 500 fentanyl test strips were distributed
  - 100 xylazine test strips were distributed

- Misty Smith (EHD) reported that there will be a SIRN conference soon and that plans are being made. More information will be shared with the council at a later date.
- Sherry Reichert (TASC) reported that Marion parole is working to restore people back into their communities. The most needed resources include work clothing, employment and transportation. She added that the presence of peer recovery specialists makes a huge difference to those on parole. It was discussed that TASC would benefit from sharing their client needs with the Egyptian Health Department to better fill the gap.
- Bev Holland (Region 5) announced the Hamilton/White County ROSC meeting will take place on Wednesday, April 15th at noon.
- Motion was made by Danielle Camp to adjourn this meeting, with Hailey Parker seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
