Standing Coalition Business:

- Minutes from the February meeting were approved unanimously with a motion made by Katie Unthank. Holly Kotner seconded the motion.

New and Standing Coalition Reports:

- Katie Unthank (EHD) addressed the council on the progress of harm reduction kits. Her hope is to assemble 100 kits to be distributed in our community. The kits may include items such as socks, easy open snacks, collapsible bowls, utensils, Naloxone, test strips, water, cups and information regarding resources.
- The council held an open discussion on the need for an Oxford House in our area. This “home” could be a group of apartments, or perhaps a duplex. It is now permitted for rental properties to be used as an Oxford House, therefore, the need to locate recovery-

friendly landlords is critical. Keisha Fromm (EHD) has attempted to contact local landlords, but has not had success.

- Keisha Fromm (EHD) reported an upcoming conference to be held at SIC on May 22nd. The conference will host speakers and community health workers will be in attendance. Keisha and Shyla Hernandez (EHD) will serve as the emcees and Misty Smith (EHD) and Chris Dennis (EHD) will be presenting awards. More details will be made available.
- Drew Donelson (EHD) gave the following reports for Naloxone distribution from February, 2026:
 - Kits distributed-1,264
 - People trained-250
 - She added that the Eldorado Police Department will soon have a Naloxone stand in their building.
- Jerrie Baxley-Brown (EHD) announced that there is a position open for a counselor. She added that the position has not been advertised yet.
- Holly Kotner (EHD) updated the council on the progress of the “MAR cards” that are being created. The cards will provide information on MAR, and well as providers in our region. She added that SI SUPRT will soon have advertisements at Tequilas Restaurants. These 6x6 ads will provide information on the stages of recovery and will advertise that “Recovery is for Everyone.”
- Motion was made by Holly Kotner to adjourn this meeting, with Kindra York seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
