Standing Coalition Business:

- Minutes from the June meeting were approved unanimously with a motion made by Katie Unthank. Drew Donnelson seconded the motion.

New and Standing Coalition Reports:

- Chris Dennis (EHD) informed the council that the Community Impact Report has been submitted. He added that we will continue to collaborate with the justice system.
- Chris also added that “Jacob’s Well”, a women’s recovery home in McLeansboro, is still in the planning stages. It is our hope that a representative from Jacob’s Well will be able to join us during a future meeting to update us on their progress, as well as to let the council know if there is any support we can provide for them.
- Additionally, he added that a meeting will be held on August 19th at the iHub in Eldorado. SICHC plans to acknowledge the accomplishments of FY26 with a plaque to be awarded for Community Champion from our supporting area.
- Chris made brief mention of EHD’s Overdose Awareness Event to take place on Thursday, August 27th. All are invited to attend.

- Drew Donnelson (EHD) gave the following statistics for FY26:
 - 17, 612 kits distributed
 - 4, 321 people trained
 - 1, 849 fentanyl test strips distributed
 - 260 Xylazine strips distributed
- Kindra York (EHD) added that she will be attending an upcoming Opioid Coalition to be held in Hamilton County.
- Jerrie Baxley-Brown (EHD) informed the council that a “Walk for Recovery” will take place in Carmi on September 26th. The event will take place at the Floral Hall, located at the fairgrounds. This location will provide good visibility, plenty of room, and shelter in case of bad weather.
- Hamilton County free laundry events have been scheduled and the calendar will be shared on Facebook.
- Motion was made by Katie Unthank to adjourn this meeting, with Holly Kotner seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
