Standing Coalition Business:

- Minutes from the May meeting were approved unanimously with a motion made by Haley Smith. Misty Smith seconded the motion.

New and Standing Coalition Reports:

- Sharron Orrick was introduced as EHD's new Prevention Specialist.
- Chris Dennis (EHD) discussed outreach to gain new council members. He added that he has informational packets to distribute to potential members.
- Chris also shared a flyer with upcoming dates for free laundry events in our area. He said that events have grown to be well-attended, with people donating funds to help with the costs.
- An open discussion was held in regards to location options for the Carmi Recovery Walk. It was agreed that the ideal location would have high visibility and be easily accessible. The date has not been set yet. Vendors will be available from surrounding county agencies and the council plans to have guest speakers as well. Suggestions were made in regards to speakers, as well as locations. Discussion will be held among the council during the next meeting.
- Discussion was held on an upcoming "Expungement Workshop". Land Of Lincoln will be giving a presentation in September. Information will be made available in regards to

who qualifies, what charges can be expunged, as well as charges that can be sealed. More information to come.

- Danielle Camp (EHD) gave the following statistics for the month of May:
 - 1,283 naloxone kits distributed
 - 325 individuals trained to respond to an overdose
 - 325 fentanyl test strips distributed
- Elizabeth Cook shared that the action team is hosting their first free concert. Isaiah Cunningham will be performing on July 1st in Harrisburg. Food trucks will be available. This is a family friendly and sober friendly event. SICHC will have a Book Walk set up, as well.
- Mark Elliott (Wayne County Health Department) inquired on updates concerning Jacobs Well. Chris stated that he will reach out to them for any new information. The council agreed that we could work together to help them with any issues they may be having as well join together to help them meet goals, or whatever is necessary.
- Motion was made by Haley Smith to adjourn this meeting, with Elizabeth Cook seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
