MINUTES

1. Welcome

- a. 2. Approve Old Minutes- Matthew Hankin had a change to the old minutes. Section 7 paragraph b, changed “children” to “adult children”. Tracie Key made a motion to approve the minutes as amended, Toni Miller seconded. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.

3. Executive Committee- MCDAC has had staffing changes. Jordan Strong has resigned as the Recovery Coordinator with MCDAC. Lasha is currently the Recovery Navigator, but she will be taking over as the Recovery Coordinator. The Recovery Navigator position will be open for applicants through RecoveryCorps.

4. Fundraising/Sustainability-

- a. Donations- We have received an anonymous donation of \$1,000.
- b. We raised a little over \$15,000 from the Golf Scramble and Super 5k. We thank the donors, sponsors, volunteers and participants.

5. Prevention - Jasmine

- a. CGTI- Jasmine and Holly had the opportunity to take 8 students to the Cebrin Goodman Teen Institute July 12-16. One student who participated was a youth staff member and was able to lead discussions amongst other responsibilities.

Two students were PALS (Peers with Advanced Leadership Skills), and were able to learn how to lead groups. We also came up with a good Action Plan for the upcoming school year.

- b. Harrah's School Supply Giveaway- The School Supply Giveaway will be held at the Metropolis Community Center on July 29th at 5 pm. MCDAC will be present, handing out erasers, pencil pouches, and prevention information. We are looking for volunteers to help at the event. Toni, Matthew, and Tracie said they could volunteer.
