



Resolution No. 27-08

Approval of Tuition Rate

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of Governors State University (the “Board” and “University,” respectively) was created on January 1, 1996, by Public Act 89-4 to operate, manage, control, and maintain the University in accordance with the rights, powers, and duties vested by law in the Board;

WHEREAS, The Board is comprised of eight members, seven of whom are appointed by the Governor of Illinois with the advice and consent of the Senate, and one of whom is a University student selected by student peers;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Governors State University Law, 110 ILCS 670/15-45(5), the Board has the authority to set tuition charged;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Board Regulation V(I)(2), Board approval is required to set tuition rates;

WHEREAS, President Ester and Senior Associate Vice President and Chief Financial Officer Villalyn Baluga recommend approving a reduced undergraduate tuition rate of \$299 per credit hour for Fall 2026 students beginning the Dual Enrollment Program (the “Program”) between GovState and Moraine Valley Community College (“MVCC”) pursuant to which students will be eligible to earn an Associate Degree of Nursing from MVCC and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree from GovState, which rate will remain unchanged for said cohort for so long as required under Illinois state law, 110 ILCS 670/15-120, and which rate will not be subject to further discount via banded or block tuition; and

WHEREAS, The Board finds that the proposed tuition rate for the Program is in the best interest of the University because, among other reasons, it will enhance the University's ability to recruit and retain qualified nursing students.

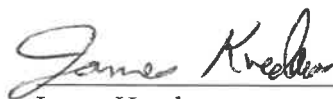
Now, therefore, it is:

Resolved, that the Board approves the proposed tuition rate of \$299 per credit hour for the cohort entering the Program in Fall 2026, which will remain in effect for said cohort for so long as required by Illinois law.

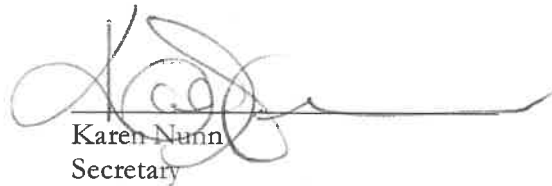
Resolved, that the Board approves the proposed tuition rate of \$299 per credit hour for future cohorts entering the Program after Fall 2026 unless and until approval of a different rate for students in the Program is sought and granted by the Board.

Resolved, that students in the Program shall not be eligible for block or banded tuition rate discounts regardless of number of credit hours taken per semester and shall be charged all applicable fees at the regularly scheduled fee rates.
