Minutes

The Recovery Housing Committee received an update on the progress of the recovery housing project. Fine Lines Drafting will begin developing construction drawings, and the location for the recovery home has been established. The committee discussed plans to meet again toward the end of September. Signage for the property was also discussed, including a yard sign indicating that the recovery home is coming soon. It was noted that a new board member is knowledgeable about grants and may be a helpful resource as the project continues to move forward.

The committee also discussed upcoming community outreach and education opportunities. The Apple Festival on October 10th was identified as an opportunity to set up a ROSC informational table. The event is expected to run from approximately 8:00 a.m. to noon, and Seek Ministries flyers may be shared at the table. Additional discussion focused on addressing facts and myths surrounding recovery housing, sharing recovery housing success stories, and continuing to provide education to the community. The committee discussed partnering with recovery housing organizations to gather and share positive outcomes and recovery stories, as well as using NARR resources and Facebook to support educational messaging. Indiana was also mentioned as a potential resource for information or examples. Seek Ministries representatives shared that they recently visited LifeLine Connect in Urbana and met individuals who may be helpful as the recovery housing project progresses.
