

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Health Sciences in Communication Disorders

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Communication Disorders degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) in Communication Disorders degree at GovState. **In addition to meeting the GovState admission criteria, students must have a grade point average of at least 2.75 for the last 60 hours of undergraduate course work attempted.**
