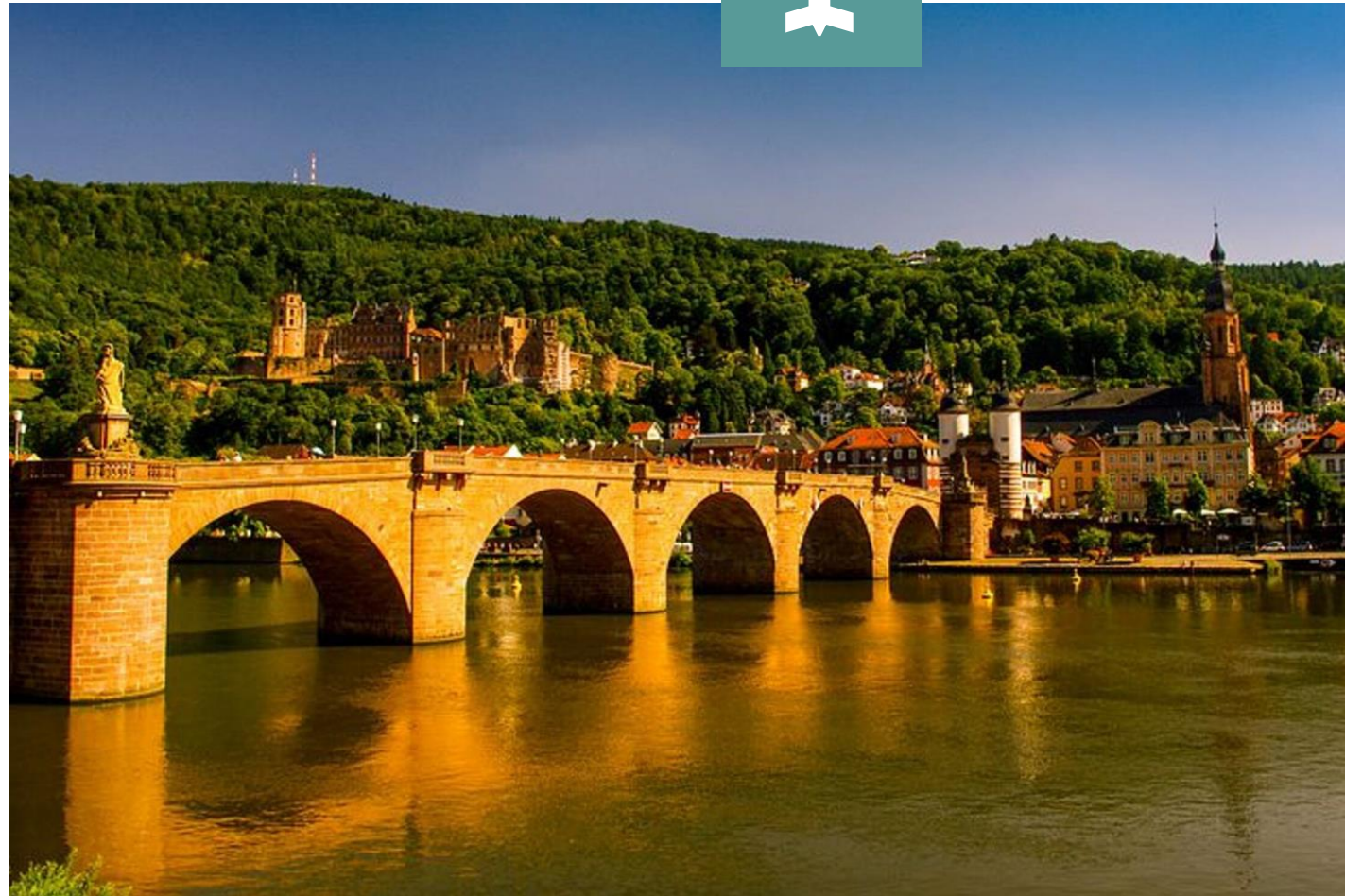

course

description

This course is designed to develop sustainable management skills and perspectives that enable students to gain experience in an international environment. The class is organized around cross cultural exercises, class discussions, visits to country businesses and municipalities, and guest speakers. The program explores varying topical themes from an interdisciplinary perspective, corporate sustainable management and public sustainable management. It integrates critical thinking and practical problem-solving skills from an array of different disciplines and perspectives, contributing to an interdisciplinary course on sustainable management.

application procedure

2. Meet with Financial Aid Advisor (if applicable)
3. Fill out the study abroad application and deposit form- due March 1st, 2020
4. Program leaders will make the final decision on participants
5. Apply for Study Abroad Scholarship
6. Apply for a passport if you don't already have one or it will expire within 6 months after departure
