GLOBAL SERVICE-LEARNING

ISA Service-Learning merges the concept of civic responsibility and community-based learning by connecting students and recent graduates with service opportunities abroad. INTERNSHIPS

The ISA Internships program, with placements available in every field of study, provides participants the opportunity to gain valuable personal and professional experience, cultural understanding and personal independence while working at organizations and businesses around the world.

The program is designed to give students a comprehensive, meaningful professional experience that goes well beyond just the placement. Internships are not built around menial tasks; instead they are intended to differentiate students so they stand out from the competition with quality placements. The application and



placement process for the ISA Internship program is centered around each individual student. Instead of a predetermined list of opportunities, our in-country placement teams seek out custom-matched internship positions for each student based on their academic background and professional goals

ISA Internships offers four 8-week Set-Date programs each year in each of our program locations: Australia, Chile, China, England, Ireland, New Zealand, South Korea and Spain. Internships are full-time, requiring a minimum of 32-hours a week at their host company. We can accommodate placements in English in each of our program locations.

We offer optional academic credit through Carroll College for our 8-week programs. The Internship course is an upper division, undergraduate course valued at six semester credits. There is an additional \$300 fee to enroll in the course.

Our recommended program locations for each career field are listed on our website. If you see a program location listed under a specific career field, it means that we can do placements in that field in that location—though the placements listed are just sample past placements and do not represent the full range of placements we can provide.

Program prices vary by program location, but all 8-week programs will be under \$10,000.

- Arts & Humanities: this career field would include Anthropology, Art, English, Gender Studies, History and Sociology
- Business and Marketing
- Communications, Media and PR: this career field would include Media and Mass Communication majors
- <u>Education</u>
- Health and Psychology and Social Work: these two fields would best align with Social Work, Community
 Health and Nursing majors
- Performing and Visual Arts: this career field would include Theater
- Sciences and Math: this career field would include Biology, Chemistry and Math majors
- Sport and Exercise Science: this career field would include Physical Therapy majors
