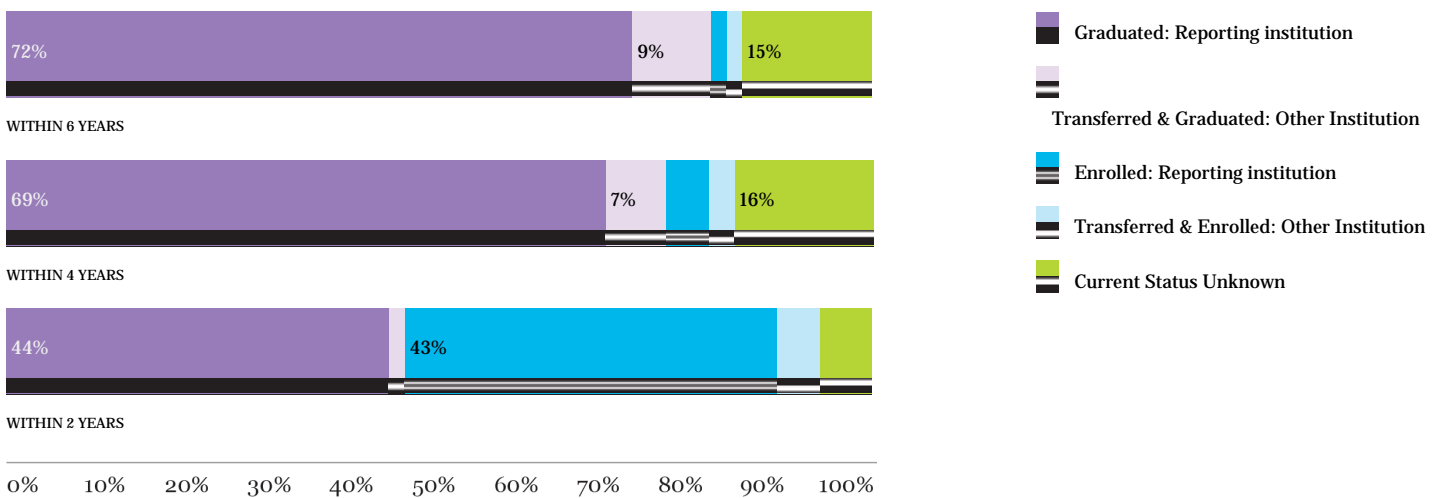

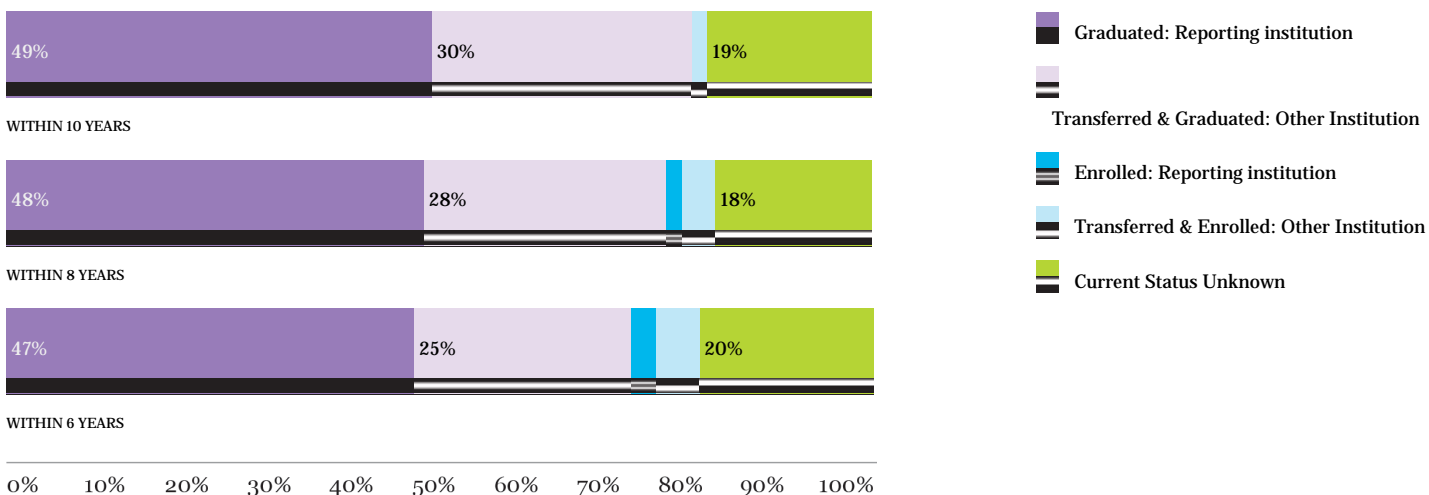


Part-Time Transfer Students Starting Fall 2006
