

## COVID-19 Programming Information: Addictions Studies

Fall semester 2020 courses in the Department of Addictions Studies and Behavioral Health, Masters in Health Sciences, will be delivered remotely with few exceptions.. The program has temporarily altered its format for didactic and clinical course instruction in order to maintain Center for Disease Control (CDC) and State of Illinois guidelines during the Covid-19 pandemic.

### Fall Courses and Modifications

Graduate didactic courses will be offered primarily remotely and asynchronously and/or synchronously. Faculty/instructors will notify students through the Blackboard course shell and/or email students directly to announce expectations for their specific courses. **Students must be available during scheduled class meeting times.** Faculty may opt to hold synchronous classes only or plan to be generally asynchronous with some planned dates for virtual meetings.
