- 2. Attach all CDIS course self-evaluations (including instructor feedback if available).
- 3. Attach an unofficial copy of your <u>GSU transcript</u> AND all other transcripts <u>documenting completion</u> <u>of undergraduate course requirements</u> (especially courses completed after admission to the graduate program).
- 4. Attach an official copy of results from a "test of basic skills" (i.e., ACT or SAT with writing) to document that you have <u>taken</u> the test. By signing this document, I understand that I will need to <u>PASS</u> a test of basic skills no later than the <u>semester preceding</u> practicum in a school setting.

You may submit the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) only if passed prior to June 30, 2019.

- 5. Attach documentation that you have completed the program's required speech-language-hearing screening (CDIS Speech-Language-Hearing Screening Verification form).
- 6. Using your course self-evaluations, write a letter of petition for candidacy summarizing areas of strength and need (related to academic, social/behavioral, and communication). Note how you plan to move forward with strengths or remediate areas of need. Your letter should be 3-4 paragraphs.
- 7. Attach documentation that you have created an ELIS account (required for ISBE licensure).
