What is Authentic Shared Decision Making



Shared decision making (SDM) is a management paradigm that empowers patients as partners in their own care in a bidirectional exchange of information and values and optimize the decision-making process.

Implementing shared decision making is challenging but **possible**.

No one intervention will succeed in isolation. It requires interventions to support organizations and decisionion aids!

What are decision aids

Decision aids are a part of a shared decision making process, complementing but not replacing clinical counseling. They are best used when there is more than one reasonable option for care.

BENEFITS OF DECISION AIDS


Improves

BENEFITS OF DECISION AIDS



AN EXAMPLE, OF DECISION AIDS ...

could help a pregnant woman decide whether to attempt a natural birth after having a cesarean. Research shows that PDAs lead to increased knowledge and a more accurate understanding of risk. When using a PDA, more patients feel comfortable with the decisions they make and the care they receive.




