Step 1: Attend an Info Session – must attend all sessions

Step 2: Complete Application

Step 3: Provide Financial Documents as requested – income

Step 4: Attend a series of workshops

Step 5: Take a Basic Reading & Math Test, TABE Test

Step 6: Submit an Academic Plan

Step 7: Gain Approval

Step 8: The WIOA approving office will remit the payment to GSU.

Steps vary for each student.
