## LS3C: Lean Six Sigma for Supply Chain Certification

Lean Six Sigma for Supply Chain (LS3C) is a fresh new perspective to improve Supply Chain process flow while utilizing tools that Lean Six Sigma offers. Focused entirely on Logistics, Distribution, Warehousing, Transportation and Procurement, this program prepares practitioners to analyze current trends and follow through with implementation.

## SCICBI & ASCM: Level 1 Principles of Distribution and Logistics

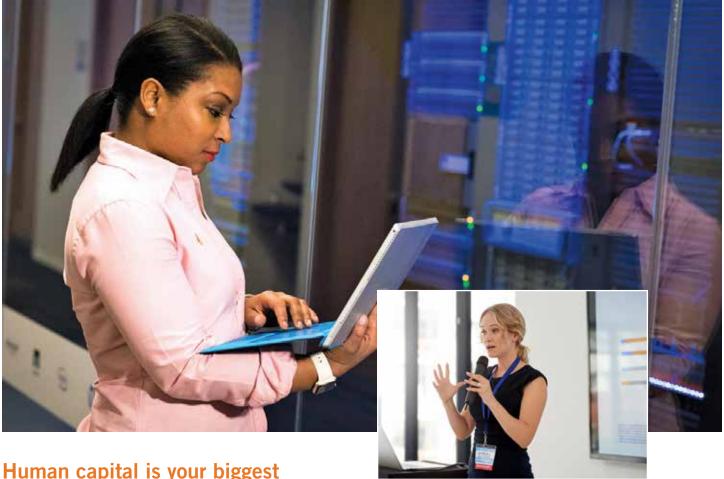
