Below is a list of undergraduate programs that have an application deadline in the upcoming summer months. Please remember, you are strongly encouraged to submit all application materials/materials for admission as soon as possible to avoid any last-minute delays. Please contact your DDP Transfer Specialist for assistance in ensuring that you have all materials submitted before the deadline.

- Health Administration: June 15
- A Nursing (RN to BSN): July 1

- Community Health: July 30
- ▲ Social Work: August 2



If you are transferring to GSU in Spring 2020, make sure to apply for the <u>GSU Promise Scholarship</u>, <u>DDP Honors Scholarship</u>, and/or the <u>DDP</u> <u>Chicago STAR Scholars Scholarship</u>. These scholarships are only available to DDP students, so you have less competition than with other scholarships. Students who qualify for multiple are encouraged to apply for all those they are eligible for, although students may only be awarded one. **Applications for Spring 2020 transfer students will be due on Friday, October 4<sup>th</sup>!**
