

DDP Chicago STAR Scholars Scholarship Recommendation Form

The Dual Degree Program (DDP) Chicago STAR Scholars Scholarship is a competitive, merit-based scholarship. The scholarship is open to Governors State University Dual Degree Program students who have a 3.25 or over cumulative GPA, are enrolled in the Chicago STAR Scholars program, and are members in their college Honors Program or chapter of Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society. There are two (2) scholarship categories: one scholarship award covers \$2,000 for books/campus dining (\$1,000 per year, \$500 per fall and spring semester) for a maximum of four (4) semesters; and the other covers the cost of an Academic Year contract (valuing \$6,316) in Prairie Place Residence Hall for a maximum of two (2) years.
