The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program was created to provide grants up to \$4,000.00 a year to undergraduate, post-baccalaureate, and graduate students who agree to serve for at least four years as full-time "highly qualified" teachers in high-need fields in public or not-for-profit private elementary or secondary schools that serve students from low-income families. The basic eligibility criteria are: complete a FAFSA, be a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen, be enrolled in a TEACH Grant-eligible program, maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25, complete TEACH Grant Counseling, and sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS). You can find the link for the TEACH Grant Counseling and the ATS at https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/launchTeach.action We recommend that only students who are committed to teaching a high-need subject in a designated low-income school upor graduation should consider this grant. This teaching obligation must be completed in a public or nonprofit elementary or secondary school that is eligible for Title 1 assistance.
