****Please Note:** These are values based on Section 4 of the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act according to the Senior Citizens Courses Act (110 ILCS 990).*

Students accepted for admission that are 65 years of age or older and meet the above criteria shall be permitted to enroll in regularly scheduled courses, on a credit or noncredit basis, without the payment of tuition, provided that available classroom space exists and tuition-paying students enrolled constitute the minimum number required for the course. This regulation shall not apply to courses offered only on a noncredit basis or to courses designed especially for senior citizens. **This application must be completed for each term that the waiver is desired.**

Accordingly, senior citizens are required to provide income documentation. A copy of the 2020 Tax Return Transcript or a 2020 Non-Filer Statement from the IRS must be submitted with this application as income documentation.
