

THE UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM
COURSE CONTRACT

A major component of The University Honors Program is that students complete one course of advanced “honors” work within their academic programs. Any advanced level course can be used for this purpose. The University Honors Committee recommends that, in courses where graduate students may register, honors students complete the graduate level requirements. While this is a general guideline, the purpose of this component is to allow students to do advanced studies, above and beyond their normal course work, so as to provide them with greater depth within their academic programs. This principle should apply to 3000 level courses as well.

Early in the term the instructor and honors student should meet to determine the appropriate and relevant advanced work within that particular course that will satisfy honors consideration. Please note, this agreement is based solely on the academic judgment of the instructor. This contract is simply a statement of agreement and expectations. The honors student will hold the signed contract until the end of the semester at which time the instructor will sign it at the appropriate place signifying that the student has completed the advanced work with at least a grade of “B” or better.
