Applicant Requirements:

- Applicants must be admitted by November 15, 2021.
- Must have a 3.75 unweighted High School GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Complete and submit the requirements listed below by December 1, 2021
- Complete the FAFSA no later than December 1, 2021 (recommend completion in October each year).
- Submit a document not to exceed one page in length that includes activity outside of required coursework within the last 4-5 years.

Expectations of Presidential Scholarship Winners as GSU Students:

- Maintain at least a 3.5/4.0 cumulative GPA (evaluated after each semester)
- Maintain good academic and behavior standing with GSU
- Participate in the GSU Honors Program freshman-senior years. Earn at least two HP points toward graduating with honors and complete appropriate HP experiences each academic year.

Recommendation Letters:

- Submit two letters of recommendation from teachers or school officials by December 1, 2021.
- Letters sent to honors@govst.edu.
- Letters must be on school letterhead and sent from the official school email address.
