<b>Desired Outcomes and Achievements</b> (Identify results expected)	Create awareness of safe on campus resources, which will allow students to take advantage of on-campus assistance through GSU4U. Engagement of Faculty and Students to assist students in need. Lower the rate of students dropping out due to hunger and/or homelessness.
