How can we help?

- **Non-Academic Grievances and Complaints:** Provides an opportunity for students to share their feedback, questions, or concerns. For more information, visit www.govst.edu/studentcomplaints
- **GSU4U:** Connects students, particularly those experiencing basic needs insecurity, to campus and community resources. For more information, visit www.govst.edu/gsu4u
- **Absence Notification:** Provides e-mail notification to university faculty/staff in the event of a student experiences a major documented illness/injury of three or more days. For more information, visit <https://www.govst.edu/studentabsence/>.
- **CARE Team (Student Concerns):** Responds to concerns about students and provides proactive intervention and timely outreach to students who are believed to be in distress or who are displaying concerning behaviors. For more information, visit www.govst.edu/care

How you can help!

Refer a Student

As faculty and staff, you may come into contact with students who are struggling and/or in need of extra assistance. Not sure where to start? Refer students to the Office of the Dean of Students! Our team can help students navigate campus and community resources and find the best action plan for them.

Share Information

Most university employees, unless specifically exempted, must immediately report:

- Serious infractions of the Student Code of Conduct, including, but not limited to: the destruction of property; possession of a weapon; use, sale, or possession of controlled substances (drugs); or violations of local, state, or federal law;
- Allegations or disclosures of sexual misconduct, including but not limited to sexual assault, sexual harassment, dating/domestic violence, and stalking; and
- Other behavior that poses an imminent risk to the safety of any member of the university community, including but not limited to threats or acts of violence.
