<b>Objective 1:</b>	<b>Conduct annual screenings to identify students with mental health needs and offer counseling services.</b>
<b>Action Items</b>	Conduct onsite and online National Depression Screening Day in October 2015 and National Alcohol Screening Day during the Spring 2016 semester; provide external referral sources to all participants.
<b>Indicators and Data Needed</b> (Measures that will appraise progress towards the strategic objective)	Number and results of two screenings (online and onsite); follow-up contacts for a counseling appointment
<b>Responsible Person and/or Unit</b> (Data collection, analysis reporting)	Emily Petkus, Clinical Mental Health Counselor Katherine Helm-Lewis, Clinical Psychologist/Training Supervisor Counseling interns.
<b>Milestones</b> (Identify Timelines)	October 2015 and during the Spring 2016 semester
<b>Desired Outcomes and Achievements</b> (Identify results expected)	25% of students who receive a recommendation for follow-up services after National Depression Screening Day will contact the counseling center for an appointment. 5% of students who received a recommendation for follow-up services after National Alcohol Screening Day will contact the counseling center for an appointment.

<b>Objective 2:</b>	<b>Increase immunization compliance of students and assess late fee when necessary.</b>
<b>Action Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refine internal annual immunization communication calendar to increase number of email reminders to students;</li> <li>• Implement late fee process in collaboration with business office;</li> <li>• Update immunization website each semester</li> <li>• Update 4 page immunization mandatory form to 1 page</li> </ul>
<b>Indicators and Data Needed</b> (Measures that will appraise progress towards the strategic objective)	Increase compliance numbers from 2014; Upload revised, current mandatory form onto immunization website; Amount of funds collected via late fee
<b>Responsible Person and/or Unit</b> (Data collection, analysis reporting)	Teresa Marez, Health Records Technician
<b>Milestones</b> (Identify Timelines)	Follow dates on communication calendar
<b>Desired Outcomes and Achievements</b> (Identify results expected)	Increase compliance to 65% and submit Illinois state report in October 2015

<b>Objective 3:</b>	<b>Create and update a comprehensive website for the prevention of sexual violence that includes all the local and national links, resources, and current definition(s).</b>
<b>Action Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ASAP website is live and linked to various webpages on campus</li> <li>• Site monitored for updates, current prevention programming events</li> </ul>
