

## Associate of Science in Business to Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for Business Administration degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Science (AS) in Business degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business Administration from GSU.
